





BARTON ROOM LEVEL 1







The Yarn Store Passport is a new project-bag sized record 1've designed for three main reasons:

- to support Yarn Stores (brick & mortar, online, markets) to encourage more visitors & sales
- to support guilds and other organisations to encourage visitors to engage in different ways with their events



- Use the wish list to record others' yarn store recommendations
- Take your Yarn Store Passport with you when you visit your LYS.
- If there's no sticker on the wrapping, cut logos from invoice from indie dyers and stick that in your book!
- Collect stickers/ stamps from vendors at knitting/crochet yarn festivals
- Take your Yarn Store Passport on holidays with you-just in case!
- Gift a copy to other yarny friends and suggest a DIY yarn crawl using the template.




Yarn Swap
